Wharf Lane Building

Construction of the basement structure is progressing well, and the building is now beginning to emerge above ground level.

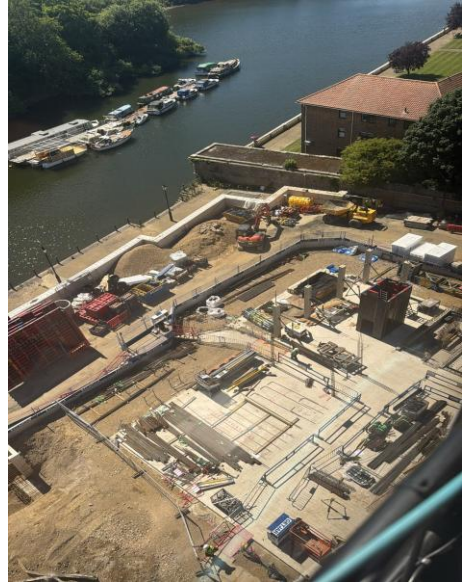
Significant progress has been made on the ground floor slab, which is now nearing completion. This marks an important stage in the construction programme and prepares the building for the next phase of vertical construction.

Water Lane Building

Excellent progress continues on the Water Lane building. The forming of the ground floor slab and installation of the ground floor precast columns has now been completed. Construction of the first-floor slab is also approaching completion.

As these structural works progress, the shape of the new building is becoming increasingly more visible through our vision panels on the King Street hoarding.

Works to construct the new flood defence wall continue along the riverside. This important infrastructure will provide enhanced flood protection for the development and the surrounding area while contributing to the long-term resilience of Twickenham's riverside.



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Upcoming Works on Site:

Over the month of July, you can expect to see:

- Continued construction of the Wharf Lane and Water Lane structures.
- Ongoing works to the new flood defence wall.
- Delivery of construction materials and concrete to support the next phases of the project.

We want to reassure you that our team will take every reasonable step to minimise disruption, and any activities that may have a greater impact on our neighbours will be communicated in advance.
